Liberty Corners in Streetsboro sold

A Streetsboro office and retail complex valued at more than \$2 million has changed hands. The Cooper Commercial Investment Group, part of local brokerage firm NAI Daus, handled the transfer of Liberty Corners shopping center and a 9,585-square-foot office building on Market Square Drive. The sale price was not disclosed, but the transfer took place at a capitalization rate of nearly 6 percent. The property has a market value of \$2.14 million, according to the Portage County auditor's office. An unidentified out-of-state investor picked up the ownership interest from Ohio-based Vining Property Management LLP. Tenants at Liberty Corners include American Family Insurance, HoneyBaked Ham and Kent Credit Union.
