SHOPPES OF GALLOWAY SELL FOR \$3.3M

COLUMBUS, OHIO — The Shoppes of Galloway, a 28,538-square-foot retail plaza in Columbus, has sold to a private group based in Youngstown, Ohio, for \$3.3 million. The property was constructed in 2004 and is 90 percent occupied.

Tenants include Chase Bank, Verizon Wireless and Great Clips. Dan Cooper of Cooper Commercial Investment Group represented the sellers, a private group based in Cincinnati. He also secured the buyers.
